

The angel letter

If a child wants to tell its wishes, or worries, to an angel, introduce the possibility of writing an Angel Letter. But you should make it clear that angels do not let skateboards, playstations or i-phones drop from the sky ...



» Talk to the child about its wish/worry.



» Get some wonderful notepaper (maybe gold or silver, or with angels printed on, etc.).



» Let the child write a letter to the angel world on its own, or support it.



»

Now the child can draw an Angel Symbol spontaneously.



» Either put this symbol into the envelope together with the letter, or just put it on the letter.



» Read the corresponding children's story from the book, if your child wants to.



» Next day the child can remove the symbol again. The letter should remain there!



» As soon as the wish has been fulfilled, the letter can be destroyed. Do not forget to thank the angels with a flower, a stone or a white feather!

NOTE: Not all wishes are fulfilled. If they do not fit into the divine order of the child, or another person affected, then you/your child will get hints from outside, after some time. You should either change the wish, or let it go. Destroying an angel letter, without the fulfilment of the wish, can be a great relief, or at least an important learning process.
